Communication & Language

Enjoys listening to longer stories and can remember what is happening Continue to develop a wider range of vocabulary Understand a question Sing a large repertoire of songs Use longer sentences Start a conversation with an adult or friend

Mathematics

Begin to develop fast recognition of objects up to 3 Recite numbers past 5 Say one number for each item in order
Show finger numbers to 5 Compare quantities
Explore 2D shapes
Describe a familiar route
Begin to understand positions - e.g. under, behind Talk about patterns
Create simple ABAB patterns
Compare objects related to size

Take part in simple pretend play
Explore different materials freely
Join different materials
Explore colour and colour mixing
Listen with increased attention to sounds
Play instruments
